Inactive Members

All existing “Member” accounts belonging to individuals who *ARE NOT* active members of the AMDCC Executive Steering Committee (ESC) or External Advisory Board (EAB) on August 10, 2006, will be closed August 31, 2006. Current members of both the ESC and EAB can be found at <http://www.amdcc.org> under “committees.”

Outgoing Members

All existing “Member” accounts belonging to individuals who *ARE* active members of the AMDCC ESC or EAB on August 10, 2006, but *WILL NOT* be active members on September 1, 2006, will remain open until August 31, 2007. This one year grace period is intended to allow outgoing members of the consortium ample time to upload and analyze ongoing experiments. If need be, an outgoing member may request from NIH Program staff an extension beyond August 31, 2007.

Continuing Members

All existing “Member” accounts belonging to individuals who *ARE* active members of the AMDCC ESC or EAB on August 10, 2006, and *WILL* continue to be active members on September 1, 2006, will remain open.

New Members

New members of the AMDCC ESC or EAB will be eligible to open a “Member” account on September 1, 2006.
